Be Careful Where You Leave Your Magnifiers!

We know that many of you will have magnifiers and magnifying mirrors and some of you may take them near to windows to help support your vision. We wanted to remind you about using and storing them safely. Magnifiers, magnifying mirrors, and glass ornaments such as paperweights, when exposed to direct sunlight could cause fires, so it is important to keep them away from windows or direct sunlight.

This is an all year-round risk, not just when it's hot in summer! They tend to start in the winter when the sun is low in the sky as they focus and intensify the sun's rays. This results in a concentration of heat that can reach incredibly high temperatures and cause nearby objects such as curtains to scorch or charr, potentially leading to smoke, smouldering or even an actual fire.

Reflected light triggering fires are not rare and could have disastrous consequences. Please keep things such as magnifiers away from windows and install smoke detectors.
